Take 2<sup>nd</sup> turning on left signposted St Nicholas at Wade (M), to cross bridge over A299. Bearing left, then turn left to rejoin A299 (M) westbound Sign posted A299 London (5.66 miles). Continue on A299 past former Roman Galley PH and up the hill to finish in slip road to Broomfield 9 yards past LP FUGR010. TR195672.
