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- 1. Riders must negotiate all Islands in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the islands and T-junctions if traffic conditions require this. Riders MUST NOT approach and encircle the islands using tri-bars. Remember traffic on the island has priority over traffic (including riders) entering it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.
- 2. No parking at the start or finish apart from timekeepers.
- 3. Riders must not stop at the finish but will continue on to the event HQ where their times will be displayed





- 1. The use of a vehicle for the timekeeper(s) at start and finish is where appropriate and is only identified as an example for the action to be taken
- 2. The small junctions or entrances to farms/ facilities (garages, restaurants, etc) that are not identified in this risk assessment have been considered, however are not considered significant to pose a risk and therefore have not been noted.






Stocks Lane/A50 junction (Whipping Stocks public house).

1	Riders must not stop at the finish but should continue on to the event headquarters where times will be displayed.
	Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg.
2	20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic
	conditions require this.
	Riders MUST NOT USE their tri-bars between the first bollard they pass on entering the island
3	and the last bollard they pass leaving it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be
	disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.
	Care At Road Junctions. Riders must exercise care at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding
4	line causes him/her to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable
	to disqualification and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.
