4 Start on C1036	Competitor/holder up falling.	L	No additional measures required.	L
5 Riders proceed south on C1036 to turn.	Junctions onto C1036 from minor roads. All have good visibility for emerging traffic and carry only light traffic.	L	No additional measures required.	L
6 Turn opposite 2 nd tree on right of road directly after left junction signposted Morton, 1/2 mile before Hutton End	U-turn in road. The road is fairly wide and has clear visibility for a long distance in both directions.	M	Organiser to place cycle event warning signs and to post a notice at signing-on warning riders to take particular care at the turn.	L
7 Riders return north on C1036	Junctions onto C1036 from minor roads. All have good visibility for emerging traffic and carry only light traffic.	L	No additional measures required.	L
8 Finish area.		M	Organiser to place cycle event warning signs before the finish to alert both north and south-bound traffic.	L
9 Return to HQ.	Riders disperse to their vehicles on Greenhollows forecourt and Gaitsgill road.	L	No additional measures required.	L
