6	Finish 0.7 miles	FINISH just after the left hand bend opposite the gate on the left hand side of the road.		LOW	Organiser to ensure riders are reminded at signing-on not to attempt a U-turn after finishing.

NOTES: A safe HC, with adequate road width and good road surface.

- 1. The use of a vehicle for the timekeeper(s) at start and finish is where appropriate and is only identified as an example for the action to be taken.
- 2. The small junctions or entrances to farms/facilities (garage, eatery, etc) that are not identified in this risk assessment have been considered,
