4	Start in lay-by on A590 west of slip road to Levens Bridge	Competitor/holder up falling.	L	No additional measures required.	L
5	Slip road on left where A6 joins onto A590.	Fast traffic joining A590 from slip road to left of riders.	M	Organiser to place minimum of 3 cycle event warning signs on slip road and position marshal to warn traffic. Organiser to display notice at signing-on warning riders to take particular care at this junction.	L
6	A590 westbound to turn	Junctions onto A590 from minor roads and Little Chef. All have good visibility for emerging traffic and all carry only light traffic.	L	No additional measures required.	L

7 Meathop roundabout - Lindale bypass	Riders encircle roundabout. Fast traffic joining. Riders need to enter centre of roundabout in front of passing traffic.	M	Organiser to place cycle event warning signs and position marshals at both exits of the roundabout. Organiser to display notice at signing-on warning riders to take particular care at this junction.	L
8 A590 eastbound to finish.	Junctions onto A590 from minor roads and Little Chef/Garage. All have good visibility for emerging traffic and all carry only light traffic.	L	No additional measures required.	L
9 Finish area with timekeepers only on grass verge.	Riders turn left onto slip road. Finish is on slip road before junction.	L	Organiser to display notice at signing-on warning that no times will be given to competitors or supporters at finish and that riders must not stop after passing finish timekeeper.	L
10 Return to HQ	Riders cross onto entrance slip road to A590 to return to HQ.	L	Organiser to place cycle event warning signs on approaches to junction.	L
