#### **Course Description:**

#### START

On the A537 at a "JS1" mark in the centre of the lay-by approx, 500yds.west of the A34 at Monks Heath.

Proceed West on the A537 Via Chelford Island (third exit) TO:

BOOTHS HALL ISLAND 5.268 m encircle the island and retrace via Chelford Island (second exit) TO:

**FINISH** 10.000 m at a "JF1 " mark adjacent to the second stud back from the far end of the 1st lay-by after Chelford Island.

 Riders must negotiate all Islands in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the islands and T-junctions if traffic conditions require this. Riders <u>MUST NOT</u> approach and encircle the islands using tri-bars. Remember – traffic on the island has priority over traffic (including riders) entering it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.
