#### **Course Description**

START on the B6306 west of Edmundbyers (opposite the sign indicating the Town Boundary) and proceed in the direction of Blanchland. Turn left onto minor road at Bridge End, just before Blanchland, and continue through Allenshields to the T Junction with the minor road at Bale Hill. Turn left onto Bale Hill minor road in the direction of Stanhope to the T Junction with the B6278. Turn left onto the B6278 in the direction of Edmundbyers. FINISH on the B6278 alongside lay-by just before the sign indicating the southern boundary of Edmundbyers.

#### **General Safety Notes and Requirements**

- · Vehicles of competitors/officials/marshals/helpers to be parked safely and without hindrance to other road users.
- · All officials/marshals/helpers to wear fluorescent jackets or high visibility clothing.
- Marshals are to be briefed as to the extent of their roles/duties prior to the event.
- A marshal's sole duty is to clearly indicate the route the rider is to follow before the rider reaches the marshal point (the rider may be unfamiliar with the course). This is done by either pointing out the direction of travel or holding a directional arrow/marker marshals should not shout instruction or attempt to control the traffic in any way or interfere with its movement on the highway (Guidance Note 11).
- Whenever possible, marshals should be able to communicate with the organiser by mobile phone in case of accident/emergency

#### **Rider Safety Notes**

- Take extra care at all road junctions (which includes not taking left hand turns wide) and on the steep descents with bends. Please note there are a total of three cattle grids on this course care to be taken on all three cattle grids, particularly on the second and third cattle grids (descending Meadows Edge and towards the finish at Edmundbyers). Riders to ensure a direct line across all cattle grids to prevent slippage (SLOW DOWN!)
- Beware of sheep straying onto the moorland roads.
- No U-turns to be made in the vicinity of the timekeeper(s).
- Road surface conditions may change depending on the season, weather, or condition of the road. It is the rider's responsibility to ride in such a manner that allows them to ride safely and with consideration to other road users at all times. Section of minor road before the left turning towards Bale Hill is very poor riders to pick a safe line.
- Head down riding is prohibited and will result in disqualification.
- It is the responsibility of the rider to check the On-The-Day Risk Assessment to be aware of any extra hazards or changes they should be aware of.

- Every competitor MUST have, fixed to their machine, both a front and rear-facing, working light (either constant or flashing). These must be clearly visible (Regulation 14).
- Every rider MUST wear a helmet that conforms to current Safety Standards (Regulation 15), and it is their responsibility to ensure it fits correctly and is in good condition/undamaged.

- 1. Marshal with red flag.
- 2. Two red flags, one positioned either side of the road, approximately 25 metres BEFORE the cattle grid.



\*\* Due to poor road surface immediately before and after the last cattle grid on this course, this course can be shortened to avoid the need for riders to continue racing over this location\*\* There is a layby a little further back for Timekeepers to park their car – suggest finish line is at the traffic sign depicting "Horse & Rider).




Image above: Temporary finish line for M14 course.

- 1. Marshal to assist Timekeeper.
- 2. Cycle Event sign positioned approximately 100 metres AFTER the finish line to warn traffic approaching from the direction of Edmundbyers.
- 3. See Safety Notes to riders no stopping at finish line.
