

Lower Dicker Diamond Drive junction road works BN27 4EL

Diamond Drive is a new road in to an industrial estate where Vacgen Ltd is already established.

Peter Moon and I checked the road works at BN27 4EL Lower Dicker by Diamond Drive last night [Friday evening] and we are OK to go ahead and use the G50/89 with two turns at Boship RBT on Sunday.

The construction of the pedestrian island in the centre lane is not yet complete, so riders need to be aware of the situation and take care accordingly.

The centre lane is coned off with the outer lanes full width, but a little narrow. Please check the three photos below.
