

NOTES TO COMPETITORS
NUMBERS: CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITION 2(j)

Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arms facing forwards.

USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

As this event is over 100km regulation 22 (c) must be adhered to - (c) Where vehicles are to be authorised a full description of the vehicle and registration number shall be given to the event promoter prior to the start of the competitor. A competitor shall not be overtaken by his support vehicle more frequently than once every 10 miles. Where possible the vehicle must be driven at normal traffic speed and must not follow the competitor, nor impede or annoy other competitors. Any competitor whose authorised vehicle impedes or causes annoyance to any other competitor shall be liable to disqualification from the event. Where any other vehicle precedes or follows for any length of time, or frequently passes a competitor, that vehicle shall be deemed to be associated with that competitor who shall be liable to disqualification from the event.

REGULATION 14(i)

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users. **REGULATION 14(j)**

(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 15

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078

REGULATION 17: SIGNING-ON SHEET AND SIGNING-OUT SHEET

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s) and (ii) sign the official Signing-out Sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF. N.B. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

THIS EVENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A DOPING CONTROL

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.

Origin of the Welsh Cycling Association

At one time individual clubs in South Wales, such as Acme Wheelers and Glamorgan Road Club promoted Open 12 Hour events: this was in the late 1920's. By the early 1930's no club felt it had the resources to run it alone so the South Wales Cycling Association was formed with the chief purpose of promoting this. The name changed to the Welsh Cycling Association to more reflect the participation from North Wales based clubs. The Welsh Cycling Association is now the controlling body for all Welsh Championship Time Trials promoted under Cycling Time Trials regulations.

Time trialling has changed enormously since those early days but the basic concept is still the same. The requirement and goodwill of having helpers and supporters to run events is as important today as it has ever been. The Welsh CA has been promoting the 12Hr for over 90 years. With your continued support we will soon make it one hundred years!

Rider Safety & Notes to Helpers

Riders & Helpers should read this section with particular care

Obey all traffic regulations – the police monitor compliance at various points during the event – please do not put the future of the 12 at risk with irresponsible riding

- 1 **Traffic lights on A465:** the traffic lights on Llangula Bridge (at approx. 60 & 82 miles) can detect a cycle and change for it. There are police video cameras monitoring these lights SO DON'T JUMP THEM!. There are 'temporary ' (i.e. 12+ months) lights just beyond, covering a house damaged by a lorry: please obey them!
- 2 **Helmets:** all competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet of a hard/soft shell construction of a recognised standard.
- 3 **Lights:** all competitors must use i) a rear red light steady or flashing, ii) a front white light steady or flashing, both of which must be fitted to the machine, switched on and working at the start (CTT Reg 14 (l & j) Everyone participating in the event is also advised to wear high-visibility clothing – including helpers.
- 4 **Numbers & signing on and off:** pick up your special RTTC Championship number at HQ when you sign on. Spare numbers are available for early morning warm up jackets if conditions are cool or to go with a change of clothing. Numbers will be given after you have signed on and **handed in your car registration form**. Any extra safety information will be given as you sign on. **YOU MUST SIGN OFF AT THE END OF THE EVENT FAILURE TO DO SAY MAY RESULT IN A DNF AGAINST YOU.** Please **shout your number** at the Monmouth garage (tunnels), Llangeview turn on A472 (Chepstow 14), Hereford (Tesco r/a) and Hardwick gyratory checking points and when passing each of the timekeepers on the finishing circuit. With poor light, flapping numbers, 'NopinZ' type cloudy pockets etc, it can be difficult to identify individual riders so please help.
- 5 **Regulations:** you have all signed an agreement with CTT stating that you are familiar with the Regulations. Riders and helpers must work within these Regulations. Please make sure your helpers also read these instructions. The future running of the event relies on appropriate behaviour from riders and helpers. Please be especially aware of **Regulation 19 'competitors must not wear head/earphones associated with audio equipment'**
- 6 **Course signage:** the course will be signed and marshalled as far as possible but not all turns will have marshals and some will not have them throughout the day. Please make sure you understand the route. Hardwick roundabout is the first you come to – it is big. First time is straightforward, take the first exit, it will be signed. The next time you get here go round the system until you are directed to Hereford (4th exit). All riders will go to Hereford and then once you get back to Hardwick you go onto the Mid Day circuit. When the first rider on the road has completed **five** Mid-Day circuits* ** everyone will then head to the start of the Finishing Circuit. *The Chief Marshal may reduce the number of circuits in adverse weather conditions. **Riders well ahead of the field may be sent on a 6th circuit.
- 7 **This event is subject to Dope Control, it is your responsibility to check whether you are required to attend Dope Control. Early finishers:** once you have reached TK1 you will be credited with a finishing distance. Tell the info desk or a marshal but – best of all – just take a short time-out and then carry on. **Please make sure you notify us if you decide to finish earlier than this (but see the note about Dope Control).**
- 8 **Notes to helpers:** all cars must be registered. Handing in a car registration form does not entitle you to follow your rider around the course. The course is dual carriageway based and there are lots of lay-bys. After the initial Hereford leg, a rider will never be more than 30 minutes away.
- 9 **Helpers must park sensibly: do not use the Hardwick pub car park** – but parking on the bit of the "old road" adjacent to the pub is fine.

- 10 **Navigating your way around the course:** riders who have vehicular support must register. Where practical, please support other riders with water, sponges, mechanical assistance, encouragement, etc.
- 11 **Frequent passing (lay-by hopping):** this is a breach of CTT Regs. **You must not pass your rider more than once every 10 miles and you must not follow your rider (Regulation 22).** Following your rider and lay-by hopping is a nuisance to other riders and road users. Especially after the Hereford leg, we strongly recommend that helpers select a suitable spot on the circuit and wait for their rider to come by. Police will be monitoring the event they have received complaints locally of people having 'natural breaks' in clear view of members of the public– please be discreet.
- 12 **Finding feeding places:** the Hereford road is no problem – plenty of lay-bys. On the A40 between Hardwick Gyratory and Raglan there are 8 lay-bys on both Westbound and eastbound carriageways and three on A449 between Llangeview interchange and Raglan Interchange (north and south) all suitable for feeding. **There is a Neutral Feed for all on the long area on the climb beyond the Raglan Castle turn to Mitchel Troy on the Unclassified road (old A40) which riders do up to five times. Afterwards, this decamps to the Finishing Circuit.**
- 13 **Visibility - All marshals must wear HiViz jackets/gilets if you don't have one, spares are available at HQ. Helpers are advised to wear Hi Viz too.**
- 14 **And finally:** to everyone - be courteous to each other, the marshals and other road-users. Fran and I calculate all finishing distances within 48 hrs to give a provisional distance. The precise final distances will take up to 14 days.

Some useful information

1. **Mobile Phone Reception.** Can be patchy along the A40.
2. **Toilets.** There are facilities at HQ first thing and later in the day. There are toilets in the Services on A40 between Raglan and Monmouth tunnels which are open 24hrs (all on the Early Morning Circuit).
3. **Fuel.** The centre of Abergavenny (follow the A40) The Services on A40 north of Raglan Interchange and the Monmouth garage beyond the Monmouth tunnels are all 24hrs.
4. **Parking** is available at the Headquarters. **Competitors please do not park in the coned off Officials area. Overnight parking (no facilities) is permitted at HQ for a small fee.**
5. **Note to Helpers** There are 8 laybys both westbound and eastbound on A40 dual carriageway between Hardwick roundabout and Raglan roundabout. There are no intersections. You will see your rider every 25.7 miles. **Do not cross the central reservation barriers or your rider will be disqualified.** Please remember that Gwent Constabulary will be monitoring your conduct during this event.
6. **HQ Opening Times** – The HQ will be open from 5:00 am to 7:30 am, The HQ will re-open at approx. 4:00 pm

There will not be food at HQ before the Start

There is a Neutral Feed Station on the Mid Day circuit on the left fork on the gradual climb on the unclassified road (old A40) to Mitchel Troy (near Raglan Castle turn). Thanks to Gareth Hill, and members of Abercynon RC and anyone else who wishes to help out.

Watch out for the Melon Man later on!

Riders without helpers can leave LABELLED bottles etc. at HQ before the Start, these will be collected by the Neutral Feed team which will be manned for the mid-day circuits. You'll have to stop to pick up. Riders - do your bit to keep Wales tidy!
Please do not drop bags & wrappers on the course
