## COURSE DESCRIPTION

- **START:** on the B1263 opposite the entrance to JWI Ltd, approx. 0.2 mile south of North Cowton crossroads.
- Proceed south westerly to Scorton village via Atley Hill.
- 3.1 miles: **GREAT CARE at entry to Scorton village – narrow bridge and oncoming traffic has priority.**
- Proceed through Scorton village direction Richmond.
- 3.5 miles: On leaving village turn left direction Northallerton (Bolton Road) onto B6271:
- Where proceed direction Northallerton through the village of Great Langton.
- 7.5 miles: **GREAT CARE – narrow road and sharp left hand turn on east side of village**
- 9.3 miles: Turn left into junction with unclassified road to Streetlam.
- 10.5 miles: pass through Streetlam (right and left hand bends – take care).
- 13.4 miles: Arrive at Atley Hill to complete main lap: Turn left onto B1263 giving way to traffic from right and proceed to Scorton village.
- 15.8 miles: **GREAT CARE at entry to Scorton village – narrow bridge and oncoming traffic has priority.**
- 16.1 miles: **Scorton village green roundabout.** Riders to turn right and right again, to circumnavigate the roundabout to retrace on B1263.  
**GREAT CARE REQUIRED Riders to give way to traffic from the left.**
- Proceed in an easterly direction back through Scorton remaining on B1263 to:
- **FINISH:** opposite the start at the entrance to JWI Ltd approx. 0.2 mile south of North Cowton crossroads: **19.6 miles.**

**All riders please note a car boot sale to the east side of Scorton village just off the B1263 will be taking place during the event. Therefore, please be vigilant whilst entering and exiting the east side of Scorton.**

CRY also promotes and develops heart screening programmes and funds medical research.
