It had become obvious to me that the popular R12/95 course based in Usk was no longer suitable. The Chainbridge route was no longer viable with long phased traffic lights on the bridge and the large increase in traffic on Usk centre's narrow roads.

I hope the balance of fast dual carriageway plus traditional (i.e.tough) single carriageway road would make a fast but fair event. The 300 mile barrier was first broken in 2019 which shows the course potential.

This is my final year as the Welsh CA 12 promoter. Old Father Time is catching up with Fran and me! I would like to thank the truly huge number of people over the years who have turned out to help the '12' in some way. Many of you have been involved in some way for 30+ years and more. For that I would like to thank you from the bottom of my heart.

I am very pleased to announce that Simon Kinsey, Virtual CC is taking over the promotion from 2024 and Simon and I will be working together to ensure a seamless handover: I'll still be around doing something in the 12 – whatever is needed.
