**WELCOME, ON BEHALF CYCLING TIME TRIALS–TEESSIDE DISTRICT**, to the 2023 Cycling Time Trials National Closed-Circuit Championship, organized by Cleveland Coureurs Cycling Club, with the support of a team of volunteers drawn from across and beyond the Teesside district. The event is being held at the Croft Motor Racing Circuit on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

**After 11 years** of being held at the Thruxton Motor Racing Circuit in Hampshire, the Directors of Cycling Time Trials decided to move the event north, and invited the Teesside District to organize the championship in 2023 on their behalf, at the Croft Motor Racing Circuit, located near Dalton-on-Tees in North Yorkshire.

**The Teesside District**, stretches from Hawes in the west, to the North Sea coast of the Teesside Valley and from Durham in the north to Whitby in the south (reflected in the header on all Teesside district official documentation), has organized and successfully delivered over many years, national events on behalf of Cycling Time Trials, ranging from the GHS (now Youth Championship and the first national final to be held on a closed circuit final) 10mile, 25 miles, 50miles and 100mile time trials as well as hill climbs on a number of occasions. In addition, a number of VTTA championship time trials have also been delivered over the recent past.

**The Venue is the Croft Motor Racing Circuit**, located approximately 4miles south of Darlington, just off the A167, is 2.0484mi (3.2966 km) long and is based on the lands of an old airfield, which has long since moved on from being a basic airfield circuit. The circuit holds meetings each year of the British Touring Car Championship and also hosts rallycross and the pickup truck racing race series. Over £1 million was invested in resurfacing the circuit some 3years ago, so no imperfections or pot holes should be encountered during your ride. In addition, road race series, cyclocross, running and triathlon events are regularly hosted at the venue. British Cycling used the circuit as part of their 2023 National Time Trial Championship course.

**The Circuit**, for a number of years has been used for cycle racing, mainly road racing, with a series of time trials introduced formally, some 7 years ago. Under the guidance and support from Keith Lawton, the then Cycling Time Trials National Secretary, a small band of volunteers created a “Come & Try It” series of measured 10mile time trials. Starting with 50 to 60 competitors in 2016, we now, in 2023, welcome up to 200 competitors at the venue on a Wednesday evening, once a month, from April through to August. Three years ago, the VTTA NEC asked us to organize a VTTA Northern “All Comers” 10mile Closed-Circuit Championship on Croft for the over 40year olds. This was considered a success, and has continued each year and will be incorporated into the district’s 2024 event programme. Over the years, a number of newcomers to time trialling, after competing in the series have moved onto club and then open events. At least one has secured CTT national medals in the Merlin series.

**THE CYCLING TIME TRIALS PARA-CYCLING CLOSED-CIRCUIT CHAMPIONSHIP**, after a trial event at Thrupton motor racing circuit in 2022, has now been incorporated into the 2023 Championship. Teesside District are extremely proud and excited to be part of the diversity and inclusion journey of our sport. This is especially pertinent for the area, as one of our own young riders, Ben Hethrington, who was forging a very successful professional cycling career (Leaders and KOM jersey winner in a number of single day and stage races) in the far east, suffered life threatening injuries whilst taking part in a local Teesside club 10mile time trial. Saved by the doctors and paramedics from the Great North Air Ambulance Service (GNAAS), after a number of years of recovery, fortunately, Ben is able to compete again and will be challenging for glory in this event. Ben is also now an ambassador for the charity (GNAAS) who saved his life by attending the accident and flying him to a specialist trauma hospital. We are proud that the annual Croft time trial summer series of events supports this charity and are pleased that they will be present at today's event, to explain the services they provide, all based on charitable donations.

**In welcoming you to the northern home of closed-circuit time trialling, we hope you enjoy your visit, by not only achieving your goals, but by experiencing the hospitality provided.**

##### **TRAVELLING SOUTH BY ROAD**

Take junction 58 off the A1(M) signed Darlington. Follow this route through Darlington, then follow the A167 towards Northallerton. Croft Circuit is signposted approximately 2 miles south of Croft on Tees.

##### **TRAVELLING NORTH BY ROAD**

Take junction 57 off the A1(M) to Darlington. At the second roundabout take the 5th exit - signed Northallerton A167. Continue on this route as above.

#### **TRAINS AND PLANES TO CROFT CIRCUIT**

##### **TRAVELLING BY RAIL**

The nearest station to Croft Circuit is Darlington which is 4 miles to the North. Darlington Station is frequently serviced by the East Coast Main Line. Contact British Rail on 0345 225225.

##### **TRAVELLING BY AIR**

The nearest Airport to Croft Circuit is Teesside, approximately 8 miles away.



**EVENT PARKING:** On entering the driveway to the circuit and passing the 2<sup>nd</sup> set of gates (& security checkpoint). continue on main drive and turn left at first opening onto car park areas. **Please park responsibly and be aware of pedestrians and cyclists.**

**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL ATTENDEES:** As Croft is an international motor racing circuit and in accordance with FIA rules and the circuits regulations, **NO ANIMALS ARE ALLOWED INTO THE VENUE.** With numerous notices displayed at the entrance to the circuit, the circuit security keep a close watch on this. With the circuit covered by a number of CCTV cameras, we have in the past experienced a number of incidents of visitors bring dogs onto the venue, **SO PLEASE DO NOT BRING PETS WITH YOU.**

**CIRCUIT RACE DETAILS: T10C** - The measured course consists of the closed Croft motor racing circuit, which is just over 2 miles in length. Starting at the speed de-restriction line at the North end of the pit lane, riders will join the main circuit and complete 5 laps clockwise. On the 5<sup>th</sup> lap, keeping left out of sharp corner, riders should enter the south end of pit lane, to finish at the chequered board, placed at the speed restriction line. (10 miles)

**RIDERS** must count their own laps and/or be aware of distance covered, to ensure they turn into the pit lane at the end of lap 5. Riders not passing the timekeepers in the pit lane or not completing the correct number of laps will not receive a time.

**SIGN-ON & RACE NUMBERS:** The sign-on and provision of numbers will take place local to the control tower (either in garage or lounge), commencing at 10:00am.

**START TIME:** The first rider will start circa 11:00am, with following riders starting at 30second intervals. The riders list identifies your actual start time. Riders must start with one foot on the ground, NO TRACK STANDS.

**WARMING UP:** The circuit will be available to familiarise riders with the course up to 5minutes before first rider starts. Following the start, the tarmac runway will be available for rider's use to warm up. No aircraft/helicopters are expected to land during the event. Please be respectful of others if using rollers or turbos for warming up purposes.

**SIGN-OUT & RACE NUMBERS:** After the event, please sign-out. Failure to sign-out will result in a DNF being posted in the results. The championship numbers can be retained as a memento of your participation or if you do not wish to keep them, please place in the box in the sign-out area, from where they will be disposed of appropriately.

**TOILETS & SHOWERS:** Are situated opposite the control tower, in the single-story wooden building. Please leave as you would wish to find them.

**MEDICAL PROVISION:** This being provided by one of the Croft's circuit's own paramedics, who will operate from the circuits medical centre.

# NOTES TO COMPETITORS

## NUMBERS: CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITION 2 (j)

Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arms facing forwards.

## USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

This event is under 100km. Riders should not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle.

## REGULATION 14(i)

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

## REGULATION 14(j)

(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

## REGULATION 15

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078.

## REGULATION 17: SIGNING-ON SHEET AND SIGNING-OUT SHEET

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s) and (ii) sign the official Signing-out Sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

N.B. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

## THIS EVENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A DOPING CONTROL

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
