**Directions to the start:-** On leaving Allostock Village Hall, turn right on to A50 towards Holmes Chapel and follow the past Spinney Caravans and take the next right into Middlewich Rd. Continue over the motorway bridge to cross rds where turn right with care as crossing riders who have started. Approximately 1/2 mile later the start is on the Right. Please leave adequate time to reach the start as it is about 4 miles from the village hall. Please **DO NOT** do a U-turn in the vicinity of the start area. Get off you bike and walk across the road when it is safe to do so.

**Course J4/20**

**Start:** On Moss Lane (Byley) adjacent to far gate post at first field gate on left after Lowes farm shop. Proceed Eastwards to:-

**A50 Cranage.** Turn left and straight on to :-

**1.616 miles**

**Toft Corner** Left on the B5081 via Smithy Green and Lower Peover to:

**6.817 miles**

**Finish**

**10.006 miles**

at a approx. 15 yds a caution cows sign about 100 yds before Wash Lane

**NO PARKING AT START OR FINISH OTHER THAN TIMEKEEPER VEHICLES  
NO MATTER HOW BRIEF.**

**Toft Corner** You must not swing wide to negotiate this corner and you must come of your “Tri Bars” failure to do so will disqualify from the event and you may be reported to the District Committee for Further Disciplinary Action.

**Riders must not make the two left turns on the circuit using tri-bars.  
No ‘U’ turns at the start or finish.**

Please collect your numbers at the signing on desk in the HQ. Do not stop at the finish, continue to 3 Greyhounds junction where turn left and follow signs back to HQ. Results will not be displayed at the HQ due to Covid but will posted to the CTT web-site after the event. Observers will be placed on the course in compliance with CTT regulations.

**Local Regulations:** Riders must exercise care at all road junctions. Any competitor whose riding causes him/her to cross the white line in the centre of the road when leaving or entering a junction will be disqualified & may be reported to the CTT District Committee for further disciplinary action. A competitor who swings to the right before making a left turn should ensure the road behind is clear before doing so. This practice is not encouraged by the District Committee and riders are warned that in many circumstances this manoeuvre will be regarded as contravention of regulation 47(i), (iii), (v).

**PLEASE NOTE:** At the 2021AGM the following new safety rules were implemented with immediate effect. In the interest of your own safety, competitors are required to wear a **HARD SHELL HELMET** that meets international accepted standards. Also in addition to a rear light competitors are now also required to have a front light fitted to the machine.  
**\*\*Riders not complying with the above regulations will not be allowed to start.\*\***
