Please note that competitors are required to personally sign the signing-out sheet within a reasonable time after finishing. Failure to do so will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.

For the Juniors event, please bring a completed copy of the CTT Parental Consent Form. Spares will be available at HQ.

F2E/10 Course Description:

START on Broadway, (off St Neots Road), south of Broadway A428 overbridge, at a point 5 yards south of first drain south of 'Give way 200 Yards' signpost. Proceed northwards on Broadway to junction with St Neots Road (YIELD), where turn left onto St Neots Road. Proceed westward for approx 1.1 mile to Cambourne north elevated RAB, where take first exit onto eastbound A428, (signed Cambridge). About 1 mile after Hardwick flyover, (after BLUE pedestrian overbridge), bear left onto A1303, signed Cambridge, pass over A428 to: **TURN** (6.05 miles.) at Madingley RAB. Retrace on A428 westbound (signed Bedford) to first A428 layby after Broadway overbridge, where: **FINISH** at drain gulley, 20 yards before end of layby raised dividing strip.

Course Change - Only the start and finish points have changed. This will mean you will finish on the A428. This is due to safety concerns of the finish Area on the previous course.

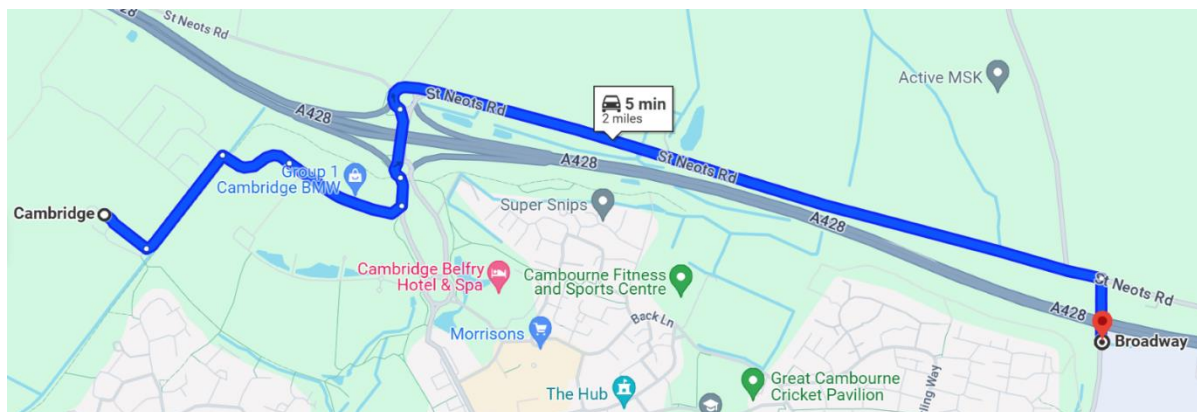
Important Safety Note:

Warning - Madingley RAB – Potholes. We have marked out the Potholes on the Roundabout. There will be extra marshals at the RAB.

Route to Start

It is approximately 2 miles from the HQ to start.

The route to the start will be signposted from the HQ. Please follow the signs from the School to the A428 towards St Neots Road to Broadway.



Route from Finish to HQ

On Finishing, please take the first exit to Cambourne and follow the signs to BMW and College.

Local Regulations & Notes

- No parking on St Neots Road, especially near the start. There is plenty of Parking at the community College.
- No warming up on the course.
- Observers may be in attendance around the course
- Riders must not make U-turns in the vicinity of the start or finish
- No Parking at the Finish
- Care At Road Junctions. Riders must exercise care at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes him/her to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.
- Vehicles must not be parked, however briefly, at the start or finish

Timings will be relayed back to the HQ from the Finish Timekeepers and Finishing Marshalls.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS

NUMBERS: CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITION 2(j)

Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arms facing forwards.

USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

This event is under 100km. Riders should not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle.

REGULATION 14(j)

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 14(k)

(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 15

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078.

REGULATION 17: SIGNING-ON SHEET AND SIGNING-OUT SHEET

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s) and (ii) sign the official Signing-out Sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

N.B. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

THIS EVENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A DOPING CONTROL

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is upto you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay
