Just off one of two mini-islands in the centre of the village. Limited Parking. Please do not obstruct roads or drive-ways. The Event Headquarters are over 2 miles from the Start ~ allow 20 minutes

#### ~ FIRST RIDER OFF AT 09.02 ~

- Please remember to sign on to obtain your race number and to sign out.
- Failure to sign out will class you as Did Not Finish.
- White front light both of No competitor will be permitted to start unless they have a red rear light and a white front light both of which may be flashing or constant.
- All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet as detailed in regulation 15 in the CTT Handbook.
- Very Avoid making U-turns near the start and finish areas.
- To avoid congestion at the start please queue in single file.
- The race takes place on a public highway and the road is open to live traffic so you must always obey the Highway Code and must not impede other road users.
- Marshals are there to indicate direction only; it is your responsibility to give way to other vehicles that have priority at any point on the route. Disruption to other road users should be kept to a minimum.
- PLEASE KEEP YOUR HEAD UP FOR A SAFE RIDE.

### **K41/25 COURSE DETAILS**

~The Course is 2.14 circuits of an 11.68 mile Circuit~

START on B4114 0.25 mile southwest of junction with the A5 (Smockington) in line with field gate on left opposite western end of lay-by on right.

**PROCEED** southwest to Wolvey 'Five Ways' traffic island (0.91 miles) ('Pesto' Restaurant, formerly the 'Axe and Compass') where take the first exit to follow Cloudesley Bush Lane towards Lutterworth. At Fosse Way B4455 cross roads continue straight on (Coalpit Lane). At the A5 'Cross in Hand' traffic island (6.38 miles) take the first exit (**CARE**) to follow A5 through High Cross and on to Smockington. Turn left (**CARE** at 'Give Way' sign) on to B4114 to pass through the Start Point (11.68 miles) to commence second circuit.

**PROCEED** around second circuit as above, with A5 'Cross in Hand' Island at 18.06 miles. Pass through the Start Point a second time at 23.36 miles, and commence a third (partial) circuit to follow the Cloudesley Bush Lane from Wolvey 'Five ways' traffic island (24.27 miles towards Lutterworth to

FINISH 0.25 miles past the turning for Compton Magna in line with the first chevron bend warning sign.
