1. EVENT HEADQUARTERS & PARKING

Event HQ: The Main Hall, Goring Village Hall, High Street, Goring-on-Thames, RG8 9AG

<u>Sign on opens at 9:15am</u>

Distance from HQ to start: **1km**. *Please be aware that you may encounter a red traffic light at the crossroads on the way to the start*

Before heading to the start remember your: number, helmet and working front and rear light Remember to return your number and sign out before leaving

Parking Information: There is no parking available at the village hall HQ. Please consider riding, or taking the train if possible.

For those that arrive by car the use of a private car park near HQ has been granted after successful negotiations with the local community.

You will be able to park free of charge in the Thames Court Car Park in Goring which can be accessed off Cleve Road. There are some areas and spaces that you must not park in. These will be signed.

Goring also has two pay and display public cars parks

3. COURSE DESCRIPTION & DETAILS

Start in Streatley on B4009 just west of the traffic lights at the junction with A329 at TP52 8 yards west of the exit from The Coombe where the pavement ends and 24 yards before the 30 mph derestriction signs. Climb up the hill for 837 yards to finish at the top at TP DP39 just past a gravel track on the left and a car park on the right. 0.475

Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the first competitor has started. Please take care when descending back down the hill

6. IMPORTANT - NOTES TO COMPETITORS:

A) Protective Helmets & Junior Riders:

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard / soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078. It is the responsibility of the rider (or parent or guardian if the rider is under 18 years of age) to:

(a) Select a Helmet that offers protection against head injury and does not restrict the rider's vision or hearing

(b) Ensure that the helmet is properly fitted, is undamaged and in good condition

Competitors **under the age of 18 years** may only compete with the written consent of their parent or guardian given on the form(s) currently prescribed by the National Committee

B) Numbers and Lights:

NUMBERS MUST BE FIXED BELOW WAIST



NO TIME MAY BE RECORDED IF NUMBER IS NOT CORRECTLY POSITIONED

CTT REGULATION: ALL RIDERS MUST START WITH BOTH A WORKING FRONT AND REAR LIGHT ATTACHED TO THEIR MACHINE

<u>C)</u> Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet:

(i) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number

(ii) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must

(iii) return their race number(s); and

(iv) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF

D) Local regulations – London West DC:

Restriction of Parking at the Start and Finish

LWDC 2 - No vehicles, except those of the timekeeper(s) and other event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish points

Use of Turbo Trainers

LWDC 3 - Noisy Turbo Trainers are not to be used at morning events within 100 yards of residential accommodation

Prohibition of U-turns

LWDC 8 – Prohibition of U-Turns. U-Turns are not permitted within sight of the Start or Finish points, nor on the course. Offenders will be liable to disqualification and will be reported to the District Committee. This may lead to disciplinary action being taken against the rider
