Course

Mam Nick from Barber Booth - OHC/10. The hill is approximately 2.1km, with an average gradient of 10.1%. Start at the bus stop (at coordinates 53.359480N latitude and -1.830793W longitude). Finish at the bus stop approx. 100 metres from the summit (coordinates 53.347597N latitude and 1.813672W longitude).

HQ and Parking

This year the HQ is back at Edale Village Hal. Numbers will be available at the HQ. There is parking available in the National Park pay & display car park, just next to Edale Station, and you will have to pay. PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE LAYBYS AT THE START OR FINISH.

<u>Please note:</u> Keep your head up while riding and obey the rules of the road. Remember that marshals are there to warn traffic, **not** to stop it. Take responsibility for your own riding at all times. **WEAR A HELMET & ENSURE A**WORKING FRONT AND REAR LIGHT ARE ATTACHED TO YOUR BIKE AND SWITCHED ON! No lights & helmet, no ride.

There are some tight corners on the climb – make sure you stay on the left side of the road. MARSHALS WILL BE PRESENT TO NOTE THE NUMBERS OF RIDERS WHO CUT CORNERS. There may be catchers at the top, but it is a blind summit so try to stay in control. Descend carefully. No warming up on the course once the event has begun. Mam Nick can be a cold descent and you might want to leave a warm jersey which we may be able to transport to the top when you sign on – but please note that you'll have to do this before 9.30am. Please note that the start is approximately 1k from the HQ – please allow enough time to make your start, 4-6 mins.

Transporting results: There is no mobile phone reception at Mam Nick. Riders may be asked to take a slip of paper with times on it back to the HQ.

This event may be subject to doping control. As soon as you have finished, you should return to the HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for testing. Race numbers required for doping control will be displayed adjacent to the result board.
