Start Time: 19:01

Course Details: Start at the field gate approx 200 yds south of entrance to Northumbria Police HQ at Ponteland on the unclassified road from Ponteland to Morpeth. Proceed northeast to Kirkley Hall. Turn left to T-junction in Ogle. Turn left, then left again onto minor road towards Belsay. Pass Ogle Hill Head Farm to junction with unclassified road A696 to Whalton. Turn left (Riders take CARE) to T-junction with the A696 half a mile south of Belsay. Turn left (Riders take CARE) and proceed south towards Ponteland. Finish at the end of the coppice opposite Dissington Lane end, approx 1/2 mile before Ponteland.

Please allow plenty of time to get from the HQ to the start.

Notes to Riders:

- All vehicles of competitors / officials / marshals to be parked safely and without hindrance to other road users.
- No U turns to be made by riders in the vicinity of the timekeeper at the start.
- No dismounting by riders in finishing area.
- Do not ride the wrong way down the short one way street near the car park.

Riders failing to observe these instructions regarding the finish area are liable to be DISQUALIFIED

- Please shout your number as you pass the finishing timekeeper.

Thank you to the timekeepers and marshals for making this event possible.

The fastest three riders, the fastest girl, the fastest girl and boy in each age category, and the fastest team of 3 will automatically have a place in the National Final on Saturday 9th September, to be held in near Peterborough.

A medallion and certificate will be presented to each finisher at the HQ once all competitors have returned.

All competitors must wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
