The horse & lady rider were fortunately uninjured and the horse did not take fright or bolt or anything more which could have had serious consequences. However, I have had the dis-pleasure of the lady contacting me and thoroughly bending my ear about not only the behaviour of the rider in question but also others, clearly associated with this event by the numbers on their back, continuing to pass the incident without slowing down or giving adequate clearance. To be perfectly honest, I find this disturbing and it puts the future of time trialling in Cheshire under threat if the local residents along Twemlow Lane fall out with us. In the same way we are asking motorists to give cyclists room on passing, please ensure we give the same consideration to other road users.

Additionally, I'm also aware that there were several riders who decided to ignore the notes and regulations on the start sheet about crossing the white lines at junctions; at least one of whom caused an incident with a car. After discussion these riders have been reported to the local CTT DC who will take appropriate action where necessary.

Please bear this in mind for future events; we cannot afford to lose any more courses on Cheshire, more so due to the actions of a few to the detriment of everyone else. Thanks,
