Course Details (J4/16)

START at a JS14 mark in Twemlow Lane, just before a property called "Timbers" and directly opposite a power pole (numbered 06/0939/6). Proceed east to the A535 at Twemlow Green, left on the A535 to Chelford Island (5.869). Take 2nd exit left on A537 to Booths Hall Island (9.904). Left along Goughs Lane to A50 and left again past Finish Mark (16.074). Left along Twemlow Lane past the start (16.963) and continue as before around the circuit, Chelford Island (22.832), Booths Hall Island (26.867), Finish Mark (33.037), left along Twemlow Lane and pass the start (33.926). Start a 3rd lap, Chelford Island (39.795), Booths Hall Island (43.830), left along Goughs Lane to A50 and left again to FINISH (50.000) at a JF14 mark on the A50 opposite a small 50 mph sign 2 yards beyond an iron field gate but before "Plum Tree Farm" approximately 150 yards short of Twemlow Lane.

# LOCAL REGULATION COVERING USE OF TRI-BARS ON CHELFORD ISLAND

Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Regulation 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. Riders <u>MUST NOT</u> approach and encircle the island using tri-bars. Remember – traffic on the island has priority over traffic (including riders) entering it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.

Please: only the Timekeeper's Car at the Start and Finish.

Numbers will be available at the HQ. You must sign on when collecting your number and sign out when returning your number. Failure to do so will result in you being classified as DNF.

#### Warnings:

#### Care at road junctions:

Riders must exercise caution at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes her/him to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification from the event and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.

A competitor who swings out to the right before executing a left turn should ensure that the road behind is clear of traffic before doing so. The practice is not encouraged by the District Committee and competitors who ride in this manner are warned that in many circumstances this manoeuvre will be regarded as a contravention of regulation 47(i), (iii), (v).

## **Twemlow Lane**

Be aware that there is a double bend shortly after turning into Twemlow Lane at Cranage. Riders need to anticipate this and be prepared to negotiate it a safe manner. In wet weather the metal covers and edges become a skid risk. Please take care.

### No U-Turns

Riders must not perform U turns in the vicinity of the start or finish of the event. Riders observed performing U turns will be reported to the District Committee who will consider disciplinary proceedings.

### IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY,

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets. It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
