Promoted for, and on behalf of, Cycling Time Trials, under their Rules and Regulations

Course V235:

START approximately 3.5 miles south of Boroughbridge in entrance to A168 from old A1 (now long lay-by) at a point approximately one yard before "Clearway" sign. Turn left onto A168 and proceed south to Walshford roundabout (4.72 miles). Encircle roundabout and retrace northwards along A168 to Boroughbridge South roundabout (12.27 miles). Encircle roundabout and retrace southwards along A168, continuing past the Start to Walshford roundabout (19.86 miles). Encircle roundabout and retrace northwards along A168 to FINISH approximately 0.4 miles beyond the Start and approximately 300 yards before Arkendale Road opposite the northern end of the crash barrier protecting a large road sign (25.00 miles).

Local Regulations:

No Parking at the Start. Parking opposite the Community Hall HQ in Arkendale.
No Parking on the A168 as it is a Clearway.
