From the flooded toilets of Ketteringham VH back in my '100' days, through the old testament style floods that almost drowned competitors when I once used a Swaffham based course, through to last year's event-day rash of traffic lights, there has often been something notable in the air. I hoped for a smoother build up this year, but that would be too much to ask...

So the traffic lights duly appeared a week before the event, and my daily checks failed to ever actually spot anyone doing any work. Then the weather plunged from benign to squall and deluge on Tuesday. Seven riders with sub-hour times shows just what quality of riders we have in the region; this is really not a fast course, and it was a hard evening. Some people had a worse night than others, but there is no shame in struggling in those conditions, so I hope you'll have another crack at it! Shame for poor Jennifer to puncture, thanks to Danny for giving her a lift back to HQ.
