Ron Brown **1922-1968.**



Ron died in an unexplained cycling accident in 1968 but he is still remembered vividly by those who knew and rode with him.

Since there now remain only a few who knew him in the flesh, it is the time for a reminder of the man.

It must be said at some point that Ron only had one arm. He himself would not have wished this to be mentioned since he succeeded in ignoring his disability and was always insisted that no allowance should be made for it.

He made cycling the centre of his life, and was an inspiration to many others through his riding. he worked at Gillot's, the South London shop and frame builder). It is said he could assemble a bike quicker with his one hand than most can with two.

Here is an extract from Mal Rees' obituary, published in Cycling 22nd June 1968. 'Ron came to fame with the Calleva Road Club in the war years being especially notable for his rides at 12 hours, winning the South Western "12" in 1945. He was 8th in the first ever RTTC championship 100 (Bath Road) in 1944 with 4.37.18 and was in the winning Calleva BAR team of 1946.


His manifold championships and wins, remarkable as they were, did not entirely account for the great esteem in which he was held by club folk over 30 years. The sport has lost one of its greatest sons, the like of whom we shall never see again.

Getting to the start (allow 5-7 minutes)

Turn left out of the Centre Proceed along chawton park road under the railway bridge to bus stop. Dismount and wheel your machine along the footpath to the start lay-by this is a safety measure for riders already on the course



Course Description: H100/88b

Start at a point in the lead out from the lay-by on the north side of the A31, approximately 10 yards east of the Chawton roundabout. (SU704375),

START OF FIRST CIRCUIT. Exit (**Great care**) lay-by to join the A31 and proceed north- eastwards along the A31 to the Holybourne roundabout.

Avoid the first exit left, take the second exit and keeping on the A31 via the Bentley by-pass to the Coxbridge roundabout at the junction with the A325 (**Great care needed**). (1st turn).

Circle the roundabout and take the fourth exit to re-join the A31 south- westwards. Proceed via the Bentley by-pass, to the Holybourne roundabout, **keeping to the LEFT-hand lane** at the roundabout.

Take the first exit and continue on the A31 past the start point on the north side to the Chawton roundabout at the junction with the A32. (Care needed). (2nd turn).

Circle the roundabout and take the fifth exit to re-join the A31 north- eastwards go past the start lay-by to **COMPLETE THE FIRST CIRCUIT.**

20.153 miles. Proceed as follows to begin **START OF SECOND CIRCUIT.**

Retrace on the A31 to the Holybourne roundabout. Continue on the A31 to the Coxbridge roundabout, at the junction with the A325 (**Great care**). (3rd Turn).

Retrace on the A31 to the Holybourne roundabout, **keeping to the Left-hand lane** at the roundabout.

Keep on the A31 to the Chawton roundabout, at the junction with the **A32 (4th turn).** Circle the roundabout and take the fifth exit to re-join the A31 north- eastwards go past the start lay-by **to COMPLETE THE SECOND CIRCUIT.**

40.306 miles. START OF THE THIRD CIRCUIT (Same as Second Circuit). (5th and 6th Turns).

60.459 miles. START OF THE FORTH CIRCUIT (Same as Third Circuit). (7th and 8th Turns).

80.312 miles. START OF FIFTH CIRCUIT. Retrace on the A31 to the Holybourne roundabout. Continue on the A31 to the Coxbridge roundabout, at the junction with the A325 (Great care). (9th Turn).

Retrace on the A31 to the Holybourne roundabout, **keeping to the LEFT-hand lane** at the roundabout. **If you move out too soon your time may not be recorded.**

Keeping to the LEFT-hand lane*, until reach chequer board by a small run-off, some 500 yards short of the Chawton roundabout. 100.175 miles where **FINISH-**

RIDERS MUST NOT STOP AFTER THE FINISH. PROCEED (WITH GREAT CARE!) TO THE HQ, VIA THE CHAWTON ROUNDABOUT. BE EXTREMELY VIGILANT FOR PASSING MOTOR VEHICLES AND ALSO RIDERS WHO ARE TURNING AT THE ROUNDABOUT TO START ANOTHER CIRCUIT.

LOCAL D.C. REGULATIONS applicable to the H100/88B course.

NO CYCLING SHOES or bikes IN Hall
Fill up the car park from behind the sports hall first to assist other centre users

- **Shoulder numbers** must be prominently displayed on the **LEFT ARM**.
- **No warming up on the A31**: use the **A32** to the south of the chawton roundabout

- **Any rider seen crossing the central reservation**, before ,during or after the event, except at one of the specific breaks in the reservation made for that purpose may be disqualified and will reported to the London West DC.



- **Any rider seen steering using their Tribars**, when entering, navigating and exiting any part of the Coxbridge roundabout may be disqualified, and reported to the London West DC. **In the interests of your safety** you must use the **widest part of your handlebars**.
- Cycling Time Trials Limited and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a **HARD SHELL HELMET** that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
- It is also recommended that a working rear light, either flashing, or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
- **Remember Regulation 17**: You **do** need to sign out or You may be recorded as **D.N.F.** This event is highly likely to be subject to doping controls. It is **your responsibility** to present yourself.
