A420 Kingston Bagpuize—Tubney Wood and Return

OS_Ref	Description	Dist
SU371975	START at the corner of the lane from Hinton Waldrist about 5 yards south of the 'Give Way' signs and in line with the north edge of the metal manhole cover in the centre of the lane. Bear left along the slip road to join the A420 eastbound. (Great care when joining A420 and give way to traffic from the right.)	00
SU407986	Proceed eastwards along A420 onto the dual carriageway by-pass and continue to the roundabout with the A415. (Care of traffic crossing on A415) Take the second exit to continue straight on along A420 after the bypass towards the next dual carriageway section in Tubney Wood	2.428
SP451007	On approaching the Tubney Wood roundabout with the A338 look behind, signal and move into the outside lane (Care) to TURN around the roundabout and take the third exit to return westwards on A420 (M, Check)	5.660
SU407986	Continue to the Kingston Bagpuize by-pass and on to the roundabout with the A415 (Care of crossing traffic) and take the second exit to remain on the A420	8.899
SU389980	FINISH, still on the A420 dual carriageway bypass, beside the first drain in the lay-by, 29 yards west of and beyond the large sign at the extreme eastern end for the crossroads to Chamey Basset and Longworth, 70 yards east of the footpath steps in the middle of the lay-by and 537 yards short of the crossroads.	10 miles

Chris Hart

Chris took on the job of District Secretary towards the end of 2007 and quite quickly demonstrated what an administrative talent the District had been hiding for so many years. His was a comparatively short span but possibly the most memorable.

His contribution included the successful introduction of and amendment to some of the Rules and Regulations of Cycling Time Trials, a feat that those who had tried before can testify could not be achieved without persistence, and the ability to argue the case, sometimes for years!

Chris was a time triallist for 56 years and it was only after his sad departure that the London West Committee discovered what a valuable servant to the District he had become. We miss him still. This is the fifth of these memorial events and they serve to remind us all of those whose dedication is responsible for the existence of sport and pastimes.
