L2521a – Course Details

START in Church Lane 10 yards North East of cattery and 90 metres South East of Throstle Nest Lane junction. Proceed North East to Winmarleigh and into Broad Lane to junction with B5272 (1.1 miles). Turn left (CARE) along B5272 to junction with A588 at Cockerham (4.0 miles). Turn left along A588 to Stakepool where turn left into Garstang Road opposite the Elletson Arms (8.8 miles) and continue to Cogie Hill (10.9 miles). Bear left into Island Lane to pass through the Start (12.48 miles) to complete circuit a second time.

At the end of the second lap, pass the start area and FINISH 80 yards further along Church Lane 10 yards before the large tree in the triangle island at the end of Throstle Nest Lane (25 miles).

Important: The following Local Regulations have been approved by the National Committee in accordance with Regulation 37. Any breaches may lead to disciplinary action being taken.

- No.17 Competitors must return to the events HQ either during or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their number and (ii) sign the official Signing-Out Sheet.
- No.4a Motor vehicles must **NOT** be parked in Broad Lane.
- No.5 Competitors prior to starting are **NOT** permitted to ride past the finish timekeeper during the duration of the event.
- No.6 Any competitor making a "U" turn in the vicinity of the start or finish will immediately be disqualified from the event.

Notes: Riders must **NOT** stand on the road near the start or finish

Riders to **BEWARE** of oncoming riders on Church Lane when riding from HQ to Start.

Riders **MUST** call their number at the Finish and elsewhere on the course if requested.

Riders must **NOT** ride with their heads down.

NUMBERS must be worn and will be available at the Headquarters, where they must be returned on finishing.

Riders **NOT** returning their numbers will **NOT** be given a time.

EVENT HEADQUARTERS: **Winmarleigh Village Hall, Broad Lane, off B5272** where the Result Board and refreshments will be available.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets.

It is recommended that a working light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
