## NUMBERS WILL BE AT THE HEADQUARTERS

### RIDERS MUST SIGN ON AND OFF AT THE HQ

**IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY**, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a **HARD SHELL HELMET** that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with **Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR** competitors **must** wear a **Protective Hard Shell Helmet**.

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is on while the machine is in use.

On the approach to the turn roundabouts riders should check behind them and take the appropriate line to circle the roundabout safely.

When riding through narrow sections with central refuges riders should be aware of traffic approaching from behind.

**After finishing, riders should proceed to the next break in the central reservation of the dual carriageway and, taking great care, re-join the west bound carriageway of the A4 and proceed back to the headquarters.**

**The start is approximately 2.5 miles from the HQ. When riding to the start, or returning from the finish, please bear in mind that others may still be racing. Please ride so as not to impede those still racing. When riding to the start, please circle the roundabout at the junction of the A4 and A340 and do not cross the carriageway into the start layby.**

### District Regulations and Notices

- **Restriction of Parking at the Start and Finish**  
LWDC 2 No vehicles except those of the timekeepers shall be parked at the start or finish.
- **Reporting of breaches of Local Regulations**  
LWDC 1 All breaches of Local Regulations shall be reported in writing to the London West District Secretary.
- No Parking on the A4 except in designated laybys.
- **The order of start shall be arranged according to a method that prevents accompanied riding in any type A event with more than 30 riders**
- There is light controlled pedestrian crossing on the course - in Woolhampton village. Riders will traverse the crossing twice in each direction. The crossing is lightly used but riders must obey lights and stop if required to do so. The crossing will be marshalled and any riders not complying will be disqualified and reported to the District Committee.
- Any riders reported as drafting will be disqualified and reported to the District Committee.

## **Woolhampton Village Hall and Parking**

**No cleats or cycle shoes allowed in the hall please.**

Parking at the HQ is limited. Please park as close together as possible to enable the maximum number of cars at the hall. The car park to the left of the hall between the hall and the houses is private and only for the use of residents of the houses.

If not parking at the hall please park with consideration for local residents. No parking for competitors on the course or at the start layby. There are various laybys along the A4 between the HQ and the start including 2 large parking areas on either side of the A4 at the eastern (Reading) end of the village. Whilst the following is not a recommendation and you park at your own risk, the Rowbarge Pub in Station Road, over the railway, has 20 spaces allocated for 'canal visitors'. If you use these please give the pub your custom, it's a good place to eat or drink after the event on a summer evening. Please be aware that the pub and its parking are the other side of both the railway and canal swing bridge which may provide two untimely obstacles to getting back to the A4 and the start.
