Hill climbing against the odds!

Thanks must go out to all who helped in organising and running this event this year, it not been without its challenges

It had already been a tough year for time trialling, with many reporting increases in road works and temporary traffic lights, road congestions and other issues which had caused issues with the safe running of time trials all over the country. Even back 1 August, on race day, we all turned up to run the event, only to learn that an accident on the M6, causing traffic to flood onto the course and the sudden appearance of traffic lights on another part of the cause meant that it was not safe to carry on.

When I learnt that there were still to be roadworks on the Cat & Fiddle, extending some distance down the hill, I quickly contacted Cheshire East Council to try and find a way round this. Despite their help, we could not remove the lights for the day, and with such a large field of riders as we usually get, and after re-assessing the course, I opted to take one of two actions – cancel or find another course. I couldn't cancel the event – unfortunately the only open road event that we would have this year, so I set about looking for an alternative. The 'Brickworks' hill is one that hadn't been used since the early 80s as an open course, although some local clubs have used it as their club hill climb route.

I therefore had to go out and measure the course, fully risk-assess it, and submit by report to the CTT local area – this being the M&DTTA. It was reviewed and accepted as a viable course, and thus we were back in business. Also last minute, was the HQ arrangements, which I fortunately managed to get by contacting Pott Shrigley Village Hall (also the Church School), which is small but would just about do.

Finally, apart from learning that a Sportive might cross our event (and learning later that there was only a short overlap), the plans were completed.

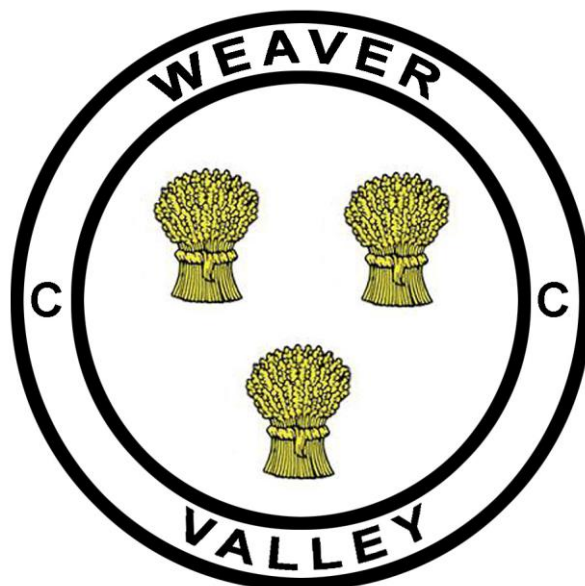
So, the day came and the early morning mist started to burn off as the women's event started, and despite only few entrants, completed with great times recorded by Alexandra Kendall-Smith, and Kate Giddings.

The men's event came shortly after, and overall was won with a fantastic time from Andy Cuningham of 5 minutes 50.9 seconds, only 2.4 seconds ahead of second place Leon Wright with 5 minutes 52.5 seconds, and 3rd Raleigh GAC pro Adam Kenway with 5 minutes 55.3 seconds. Well done gents, some good times posted there over the 1.69 mile course.

So, thanks again to my team of marshals, timekeepers, signing on helpers and the ladies in the kitchen, without whom I would not be able to get the job off the ground, and thankyou to all the riders who supported the event on the 'Brickworks'.

In 2018, roadworks permitting(!) we'll be back on the Cat. I hope to see you all there next year.
