## **Sunderland Clarion Two Stage Hill Climb**

To be held on the 24th September, incorporating the Peter Foster Memorial Trophy (Sunderland Clarion Riders Only).

**MH4: Hags Lane, Silverhills is situated to the west of the Team Valley Trading Estate, Gateshead**

Start at farm gate on left hand side of unclassified road (between Lamesley and Sunnyside) just before road bends right at bottom of climb. Proceeding through cross roads at Old Ravensworth, and on to finish at left of Hill Head Farm.

**MH20: Kibblesworth Bank,**

Start towards the west end of Kibblesworth at telegraph pole K1474, close to mine wheel monument, and proceed uphill to finish at second farm gate on left of road after 1 mile (approx.).

**Event Headquarters:** Kibblesworth Millennium Centre,  
Kibblesworth NE11 0XN

The event headquarters will be open from 8:00 am.

**Directions to Kibblesworth Millennium Centre:**

From A1, take the slip road signposted Team Valley Trading Estate. At roundabout, take direction signposted Lamesley. At next roundabout, take exit signed Kibblesworth, then take the next left and then the right turn following the Ravensworth Arms. Once in Kibblesworth take left turn immediately before Pit Wheel sculpture. HQ is on left hand side of the road. On street parking is available, please be courteous to local residents, there is also parking available at the working mans club.

First rider off: 09:01AM

Please Shout out your number when crossing the line!

**Riders please note:**

Keep strictly to the left hand side of the road, and especially so on right hand bends;

No U-turns to be made in the vicinity of the timekeeper;

No warming up on the hill once the event has started; and

No dismounting in the finishing area

**IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY**

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with Regulation 15, ALL JUNIOR & JUVENILE competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets. It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.”

Please note with effect from Sunday 6th May 2012 CTT have been asked to clarify that competitor to competitor insurance claims are not covered under CTT insurance policies.

Please ensure you sign back in once completing stage 2 when returning your number, failure to do so results in disqualification.
