James Boyman continued his winning form with a fine win on the challenging P337 course out in Holmsley in the New Forest. The Hoops Velo rider recorded an impressive 22.05 earning himself top spot and taking 34 seconds off the previous course record. Second place Craig Wallington (Sarum Velo) came home in a time of 23.55. Although 42 seconds slower than the winning time he set in the promoting clubs event back in April, the course had not then been hammered by the previous day's storm leaving standing water and leaves around much of the course as was the case on this occasion. Third place Max Webber (Abbotts Ann Cycles) completed the podium with 24.01.

In the Ladies competition, Lizzy Campbell (Iris Race team) mastered the poor under tyre conditions to record a fine 28.32. Second place went to Sarah Wise (CC Weymouth) with 29.31, and third spot went to Michelle Lock (GS Stella) in 29.50. Bournemouth Arrow rider Michelle Walter suffered an untimely puncture right at the start but managed to return to HQ for a repair and get back to start at the end of the field. The late start penalty overshadowed an otherwise good ride.

The promoting clubs Zak Snell won 1st Junior with a commendable 25.58 in his first open event.

3 riders from New Forest CC earned fastest team with a combined 1h 17m 56s. Lyndon Thompson, Stuart Peckham and Robert Veal all did a sterling job.

The Veteran awards (best plus on standard) went to Dave Dent (GS Stella) with a plus of 2.38, second was won by Nick Jones (Bournemouth Jubilee Wheelers) with a plus of 2.00, and third went to Drew Hosie (...a3crg) with a plus of 1.28.
