Event Headquarters: Didmarton Village Hall (GL9 1DT) open at 6:30 am. Approaching Didmarton on A433 from the South West, at the edge of the village just after the 30 mph speed limit, turn right down the lane sign-posted 'Didmarton Village Hall'. Take the first left in 200 yards.

There is plenty of parking space at the HQ. You can also camp there (£5.00 per pitch). If you want to camp, please contact John Thompson beforehand.

SWTA AGM starts at 11.00 am at the HQ.

Numbers and signing on sheet at the HQ. We will be using Severn RC numbers.

HQ to Start: Turn left (South West) at A433. The start is at about 0.6 mile on the other side of the road. Take great care crossing the road and avoid further U turns.

Finish to HQ Continue on A46 (no U turns) for about 0.6 mile to take the first left, sign-posted 'Didmarton 2 miles' on unclassified road. At T junction with A433 turn left, with care. Watch out for riders and traffic. Take right turn (sign-posted Didmarton Village Hall).

This event may be subject to a **Doping Control**. Return to the HQ as soon as you finish or pack.

Safety - Head up for a safe ride.

Safety - Helmets: Cycling Time Trials strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

Safety - Light(s): It is recommended that working rear light(s), either flashing or constant, is fitted to the trike in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Safety - on this course riders are asked to take care and, in particular, note the following points:

- You will have to cross the A433 to reach the start. Take great care, if necessary dismount. Avoid any further U turns and wait for your turn off the road in the entrance to the BT building.
- You will join the A46 from an unclassified road on both laps. If necessary wait or slow down.
- Descending through Didmarton is fast. Watch out for dozy pedestrians and motorists.

U109 Course: Start by BT building approx 0.7 miles west of Didmarton on A433 (GR 806869). Go east on A433 through Didmarton to cross roads immediately past Hare & Hounds Hotel (4.4 miles / Marshal). Left, with care, onto minor Bowdown Road. At Bowdown Farm (6.2 miles) care at sunken drain grids. At junction with A46 (7.5 miles/Marshal) turn left, taking great care again and, if necessary, being prepared to wait. At junction with A433 at Dunkirk (12.8 miles/Marshal) turn left again to pass start, Hare & Hounds cross roads (18.3 miles), minor road to A46 (21.3 miles). Left to finish (25.1 miles) opposite north end of lay by on right hand side of A46, (GR 800886).
