George Herbert Stancer OBE (1878-1962)

George Herbert Stancer was one of the leading lights in the formation and development of our sport.

The George Herbert Stancer 10 Mile Time Trial Championship is named in tribute to a man of many talents. George Herbert Stancer or GHS as he was known, in his early years was a nationally renowned performer on both cycle and tricycle holding both titles & records.

Throughout his career he was a leading administrator of the sport, taking over the presidency of the C.T.C. in 1920 at a time when the membership was only about 8,500. Almost from the day he took over the membership started to grow again, and he had the satisfaction of seeing it rise to over 50,000 before his retirement in 1945. GHS was also for several years editor of cycling magazine and he continued to be active in the sport until his death in 1962.

After his death a trust fund was established with aim of promoting and encouraging participation amongst the young. To this end the National Schools 10 mile championship was formed and later adopted by the RTTC in 1970.

Numbers and Signing on

Signing on will be available outside the HQ from 8.30.

All competitors **MUST** hand in a completed and signed copy of the enclosed Parental Consent Form when signing on.

Both body and arm numbers will be used. In accordance with the Championship Conditions only numbers provided by the organiser should be used. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16 and arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arm with the number facing forwards (not inwards).

Please fix numbers with pins not adhesive tape.

Riders must not stop at the finish.

No cars are allowed close to the start or finish areas except for those used by officials and helpers directly related to the event.

Route to the start

The start is 4 miles from the HQ.

From the headquarters car park turn right and proceed to Kinwarton Road. Turn right.

Continue along Kinwarton Road that subsequently becomes Henley Street, Church Street and High Street. At the end of High Street turn right in to Swan Street.

Ride 50m along Swan Street then at the roundabout take first exit in to Evesham Street. Continue along Evesham Street to roundabout junction with A435. Take second exit to join A422.

Continue to past Ragley Hall and at junction signed to Wixford and Dunnington continue to follow road to the right (Dunnington) ascending the hill. After the top of the hill and slight descent 90° left turn to reach DunningtonCross Roads.

Continue straight on (now B4088) passing layby on left to reach start at side road joining B4088 from the left.

Route back to the HQ


After passing the finish continue on the A435 to the next roundabout. Turn right to Evesham Street.

At the roundabout take the third exit in to Swan Street and then left in to High Street. Continue along High Street – Kinwaraton Road then left to the Greig.

Notes to Competitors

This event is under 100km. Regulation 22 does not allow the use of following cars.

Extract: A competitor shall not be **preceded, accompanied or followed** by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle or it's occupants.

Doing so could result in **disqualification** of the rider. Observers will be posted along the course to monitor for infringements.

This event **may** be subject to doping control. As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is **your responsibility** to check if you are required for a Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the results board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, **it is up to you to check and ensure you comply**.

If required you must report to Doping Control as soon after finishing without delay.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, and in accordance with Regulation 15, competitors must wear protective hard shell helmets. It is also recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.

Conduct of competitors in the start area.

When using the same course to run the 2014 National 10 mile Junior and Women's Championships the club received a number of complaints from residents and the Parish Council relating to the conduct of competitors. **Please note that there are no toilets at the start.**
