Riders shown with † in the Improvement Pos column had no "25" time in the current & last 3 seasons and those shown with § against their number had beaten 57:00 prior to the event.

Dry, sunny and warm and the only thing that spoiled it was that south-easterly breeze. Still that didn't stop a lot of riders from improving with 48 of the 89 finishers ending up with a new PB and 28 disqualifying themselves from next year's event having beaten 57:00.

Because of the ruling that riders who had previously beaten 57:00 before the event could not count for the prizes the actual fastest rider is not the winner of the event but I'm sure Daren Austin will be pleased to have improved by over 1 minute. Our congratulations to you all and especially to the prize winners. Neill Keaney's excellent 52:31 was an improvement of over 5½ minutes and just 1 second faster than Junior rider Sam Allen who improved by over 7 minutes. In third place was Daniel McKenny with 53:06 who had the pleasure of leading his Basildon C.C. team mates to the Team win. Debbie Coyle was very pleased with her 56:35 winning the Ladies' prize for the second year running with Jennifer Smart second with 58:55 while James Bainbridge produced an impressive improvement of 16:10 to head that prize list.

The Shaftesbury have now been promoting the MM 25 for 51 years, always with the intention of giving up-and-coming riders the chance to ride on the faster courses. The limit has got faster over the years and maybe we should now call it a Long Markers 25. Surprisingly entries were down this year, maybe it was the dreadful winter, maybe it was the move from June to April. As most of you will know the E2 25 course cannot be used during the summer months of June, July and August and May is already full of established events so we had no alternative to the April date which is where we will probably be next year.

For those of you still outside the 57 limit look out for our event next year, we'd be delighted to receive your entry.
