Course V237

START on North side of B6267 (Masham Lane) at double red metal gate (3rd gate in all from TI), approx.. 525 yards West of Sinderby TI. Proceed Eastwards before turning left at Sinderby TI, then continue Northwards via Gatenby TI to Bedale lane end TI (6.53 miles). Encircle island and proceed South along A6055 via Gatenby TI to Sinderby TI, (12.77 miles). Encircle TI and repeat circuit via Gatenby TI, Bedale lane end TI (19.03 miles), Gatenby TI to FINISH at double 2-way / Clearway sign approx. 400 yds North of Sinderby TI (25 miles).
