National Ranking System

Those who attended the National Council meeting in November 2014 will remember the discussion following the request made by several CTT Districts for consideration to be given to a national ranking points system. A working party was to be funded to look into the viability of such a system.

The working party to date has met three times in 2015. Good progress is being made and below is a press report from the working party:

National Ranking System

Following on from the announcement at the 2014 National Council Meeting of a dedicated working party to consider a national ranking system, we are pleased to report the following progress.

The working party in seeking to develop a simple system for a national, annual ranking of competitors, by ability, intended to offer a potential season long target for riders, and based upon finishing positions rather than times, has considered a number of differing systems. The equal distribution system (similar to that used by Midland District) has been identified as the one considered most appropriate to satisfy and embrace the above requirements.

Work is continuing to address the issues (cost and resource) raised by the introduction of such a system that will facilitate the submission of a proposal for consideration by the Cycling Time Trials Board of Directors so as to establish a national ranking system.

Workshops/Conferences

Organisers' Workshop

This took place on Saturday 14 March 2015. A total of 60 delegates attended what is hoped was a friendly and informative workshop. Topics covered included event administration, police influence on events, signage and risk assessment, event timing, on-line entries and drug testing. There was also an entertaining presentation by Frank Bird from the Midlands Region Highways Agency.

From the feedback received, those who responded found the workshop very useful, and indeed some said that their confidence was boosted to the extent that they would be volunteering to promote more events in the future.

Closed circuit events 2015

DIW Wheelers is promoting the events listed below during 2015 on closed circuits. These events are **not** in the handbook.

The exact distance of the events is not yet known but they will be between 8 and 11 miles.

All the events will be run on a “Come and Try” basis which means entries are not only open to experienced time triallists and club members, but also to the complete novice and non-club members.

At each event there will also be a shorter event (over 1 or 2 laps) for the under 12s to experience time trialling.

Access to the venues will be from 17:30 with the events scheduled to start at 18:30.

To encourage clubs to promote events, all clubs affiliated to CTT that promote an event in 2015 (whether an “open” (Type A) event, or “club” (Type B) event) will be able to purchase direct from CTT a set of event numbers (1-150) at a cost of **£50** (to include postage and packing).
