Welcome everyone to the first of Cwmcarn's two Open Time Trials for 2018. The 10/16A is our club course and on a good day can produce some fast times. It's going to be interesting to see what a World Tour rider makes of it, especially with a prize on offer for a new course record!

Course R10/16A:

Start at lamp standard IF21 at southern end of layby 0.4 miles north of Abercarn on A467. Proceed southbound, taking 2nd exit at roundabout to continue on A467 to Wattsville roundabout and take exit onto dual carriageway (A467). Proceed on dual carriageway to Risca roundabout **(TURN 5.16 miles).**

Turn by circling the roundabout (U Turn) to continue on dual carriageway northbound to Wattsville roundabout. Take 3rd exit signposted Abercarn to continue on A467 single carriageway to take 2nd exit at roundabout to continue to Abercarn. Bear left (WITH GREAT CARE) onto unclassified road (2nd entrance signed to Prince of Wales Industrial Estate) and in 200 yards

FINISH at light standard IF463 on left opposite entrance to Bridge Street (culde-sac) on right. 10 miles.

There are double white lines at the start. Any rider turning in the road at this point WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. Please continue for 220m past the start area to turn at the roundabout and retrace

Notes to Riders:

- Please be considerate when you park around the headquarters do not park on double yellow lines, or in a way that endangers either yourself or other riders in the approach to the finish. It is usually possible to park within the industrial estate opposite, but heed any instructions from landowners and other involved parties. Please DO NOT PARK in the layby at the start area.
- All riders must sign on in Race HQ prior to collecting their numbers and sign out when handing them back
- It is around a mile from the HQ area to the start via the shortest route (up the A467 and retrace round the roundabout)
- CTT and the organisers strongly recommend the use of an approved safety helmet. Such helmets are compulsory for all riders under the age of 18
- If you enjoyed the course or didn't, but want another go anyway, all are welcome at our weekly club TT's. Every Thursday til the end of August. Signing-on from 6 to 6.30 sharp at the clubhouse
