

## COURSE V233

### Dishforth – Walshford – Dishforth

**START:** on unclassified road leading out of Dishforth village approx. 300 yards east of roundabout, at a mark opposite LP No. DV/3. Proceed via roundabout on to A168 & continue southwards via Kirkby Hill roundabout (3.10 miles), Roecliffe Road roundabout (4.75) & Boroughbridge south roundabout (5.50) to Walshford roundabout (13.05). Encircle roundabout & retrace northwards along A168 via Boroughbridge roundabout (20.60), Roecliffe Road roundabout (21.40) & Kirkby Hill roundabout (23.10) to finish at the beginning of the kerbing leading to the last of six gated entrances to the A1(M) (25.00).

**Remember:** The whole of the course is on the A168. Continue on A168 at all roundabouts.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Marshals are only to indicate your direction, and not to control traffic in your favour. At each junction it is your responsibility to ensure that it is safe to proceed. Keep your heads up, and keep to the left of the carriageway

**There is no parking, other than for Officials, at the start and finish.**

There may be some over-lapping of riders on the section of the course. There will be Observers out on the course. Any reports of accompanied riding may result in disqualification of the riders involved, and possible further action by Yorkshire D.C. The onus lies with the overtaken rider to drop back in order to avoid accompanied riding.

**PARKING:** On north side of road into Dishforth (opposite side to start). Do not park in front of driveways, or on any planted margins. On verge to east of A(1)M (next to Dishforth North TI). Note A168 is a CLEARWAY – NO PARKING. Also NO PARKING on Rainton Lane (Police request).


## HEADQUARTERS and PARKING

Event Headquarters is the Village Hall (Willow Bridge Lane) at Dalton, near Topcliffe. The village lies to the south of the Thirsk by-pass. Access the village via the A168 junction at Topcliffe, or from A19, south of Thirsk. Turn into either Moor End Lane (signed Dalton) or Low Lane (signed Sessay, Dalton). Body-numbers, signing-on sheets, result board and refreshments will be located here. Please return your numbers after your ride. Showers are available. Please park sensibly, and do not block entrance to rear car-park. No postcode for HQ, but **YO7 3HY** will take you to the Jolly Farmer, just round the corner from HQ.

**Do not park in front of the new houses opposite the HQ, and keep noise to a minimum.**

## SHOE-PLATES ARE NOT TO BE WORN IN MAIN HALL

It is approx. 5 miles from the HQ to the start, so allow plenty of time to get there.



**In the interest of your own safety, CYCLING TIMETRIALS, and the Event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users, and is active whilst the machine is in use.**

**NB. Junior & Juvenile riders MUST wear an approved Hard Shell Helmet (reg.15).**
