Event Headquarters

Wolvey Village Hall, The Square, Wolvey, Warwickshire, AE10 3LG

Just off one of the two mini-islands in the centre of the village. Limited parking, please do not obstruct roads

Course details: K41/25 ~ the course is 2.14 laps of a 11.68 mile circuit

START on B4114 0.25 mile southwest of junction with the A5 (Smockington) in line with field gate on left opposite western end of lay-by on right.

PROCEED southwest to Wolvey traffic island (0.91miles) (previously Axe and Compass and now Pesto island) where take the first exit to follow unclassified road towards Lutterworth to the traffic island junction with the A5 (6.38 miles). Take first exit (**CARE**) to follow A5 through High Cross and on to Smockington to turn left (**CARE at “Give Way” sign**) onto B4114 to pass through the start point (11.68 miles) to commence a second circuit.

PROCEED around second circuit as above with A5 island at 18.06 miles and pass through the start point for a second time at 23.36 miles and commence a third (partial) circuit to follow the unclassified road from Wolvey traffic island (24.27 miles) towards Lutterworth to

FINISH 0.25 mile past the turning for Compton Magna in line with the first chevron bend warning sign.

**In the interests of your own safety Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
It is also recommended that a working rear light, flashing or constant, is fitted to your machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst riding**
