Important Notes


All roundabouts and major turnings will be marshalled, however, riders are reminded it is their responsibility to know the course. Please take the time to study the course map and **please take extra care on roundabouts**.

Any riders making U-turns within sight of the START or FINISH will be disqualified from the event and will be reported to the District Committee.

Riders should ride straight to the HQ after finishing, **do not** return to the time keeper for your time.

- **IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR MARSHALLS AND OFFICIALS TO STOP OR REGULATE TRAFFIC ON THE HIGHWAY**

The Course – D10/25



Course Details

Farndon / Borrass A534 D10/25

Start on A534 opposite grid in lay-by (white paint)
Approx. ¾ mile from the junction with B5069.

Proceed on A534 in the direction of Wrexham to 1st roundabout 4.26m
1st exit LEFT towards Wrexham Industrial Estate
Encircle Wrexham Industrial Estate roundabout 5.10m
Retrace to 1st roundabout 5.91m
Bear right back onto A534.
Proceed back along A534 to FINISH at telegraph pole no.A4 (white paint)
Approx. 100 yards before lay-by on left hand side 10.00m

Riders to continue to up the hill and follow the return route back to the
Headquarters – Farndon Sports & Social Club.

No warming up on course once event has started.

Only timekeepers car to be parked at the start and finish points.
