Notes to Competitors

Please take time to read and digest the notes on the back of the Start Sheet. Riders must sign on in person at the headquarters.

Any further instructions and information on hazards will be available at signing on.

District and Championship Regulations

Hampshire Police Constabulary and ...a3crg request that all riders have a flashing rear light when racing.

No cars, except those of race officials are allowed in the section of Longmoor Road used for the start.

No cars associated with the event are to park on Longmoor Road or anywhere on the course.

Strictly NO parking around the MOD site at Longmoor.

No warming up on the course once the event is underway.

Route to the Start

Turn left out of school car park onto Longmoor Road. Please note this road is a single carriageway in each direction so please be aware of other road users. Continue along this road, go straight across the roundabout at the Oak Park - a new housing development - continue past the turning on the left to Old Thorns and the Deers Hut, then take the next left into Longmoor Road.

DO NOT stop in Pines Road (on your left) but continue along Longmoor Road to join the coned area. The start is in a residential road so please be aware of other road users and be considerate to residents.

**Course Description
P884C**

START at the junction opposite Pine Road on Longmoor Road and turn left onto Longmoor Road. PROCEED to the Entry Slip Road to A3 at Griggs Green Interchange (SU 817317) South West to join A3 (signposted Petersfield and Portsmouth). Proceed on A3 passing exit slip road at Longmoor Interchange (Signposted A325 Farnham) to Ham Barn RAB (SU 772295).

At Ham Barn Roundabout (3.4) take the second exit towards Petersfield, passing the exit for West Liss at 5 mile, the Midhurst exit (A272) and the Winchester (A272) and take the Buriton exit at 9.9miles.

Follow slip road and take first exit on roundabout (10.1 miles) to re-join A3 north. Keep left here and take care to re-join A3 towards London Guildford and continue along A3 passing exit for Winchester (A272) the Midhurst exit (A272) and the exit for West Liss, to Ham Barn Roundabout (16.9 miles).

Approaching Ham Barn Roundabout stay in the middle lane, take 2nd Exit and proceed North on A3 passing the exit slip road at Longmoor Interchange (signposted A325 Farnham), Griggs Green.

At the third turning (21.9 miles) take the left turn signposted Haslemere/Liphook B2131, and continue over the flyover and next left onto the slip road to re-join the A3 in a southerly direction (signposted Petersfield/Portsmouth).

Retrace along A3 southbound towards the Ham Barn Roundabout passing the Griggs Green turning (23.9 mile) to FINISH adjacent to Clearway Sign four metres north of from Highways Direction Sign indicating turning for Farnham A325, 25 Miles.

Return to HQ

In the interest of not interfering with other competitors rides, upon finishing, please exit the A3 at the next junction (Longmoor) and then use the cycle path to return north to the headquarters. You will pass the finish timekeepers whilst on the cycle path; please pass them quickly and do not stop to ask for your time. You will come to a gate at the end of the cycle path that runs parallel with the A3. Go through this gate and close it behind you, follow the road to the end, where you will find the start, turn right at the end to make your way back to the headquarters.

REMEMBER to sign back in and CHECK to see if you are required to report to the Doping Control. If you are please do so immediately.

**Technical problems
whilst racing**

If you have a technical problem whilst racing, please use the hard shoulder. There will be officials patrolling the course and if you are unable to ride back you will be picked up. Under NO circumstances must you cross the A3.
