As a result of the strength sapping breeze times for the majority of riders were down on what they could have expected from the course along the A10.

This year's winner was Ross Clarke (TMG Horizon Cycling Team) which was an improvement on his second place of last year. His time being 2 seconds off his result of last year with a 52:59. Ross was followed by Christopher Wedge of (Whitewebbs CC) in 55:41 who also managed to take 7 seconds off his personal best. 3rd was James Denham (Welwyn Wheelers) not far behind in 56:36.

In the Vets standards Christopher Wedge (Whitewebbs CC) also stood out in first place with a +11:22 with Steve Clarke (TMG Horizon Cycling Team) returning a +9:47 behind on standard. Fastest team of three riders was Hertfordshire Wheelers consisting of Gareth Wignall, Lee Mason and Sam Ball with a Team Time of 3:25:20.
