Event Headquarters

Wolvey Village Hall, The Square, Wolvey, Warwickshire AE10 3LG

Just off one of the two mini-islands in the centre of the village. Limited parking, please do not obstruct roads

The event headquarters are over 2 miles from the start ~ allow 20 minutes

Course details: K41/10

START on road off the B4109 (signposted A427 Lutterworth at Wolvey, at the second-last catseye on the first lay-by on the left, southeast of the traffic island junction with the B4114 (previously Axe and Compass, but now the Pesto island)

PROCEED southeast to the traffic island at the junction A5/A427 (Cross in Hand) 5.2 miles

ENCIRCLE traffic island taking the **fifth** exit to retrace towards Wolvey

FINISH at road drain on left just west of tree about 300 yards before the driveway to Wolvey Health Farm

In the interests of your own safety Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards. It is also recommended that a working rear light, flashing or constant, is fitted to your machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst riding
