532673	Go west along the A4 through Woolhampton to go straight across the Kennet Park roundabout (M1) and continue on the A4 to the next roundabout at the junction with Pipers Way on the south. (Turn)	4.605

### **Riders' Notes**

Riders are reminded that the onus of keeping to the course rests with them All points may not be marshalled but directional signs will be positioned around the course

It will help if riders call out their number loudly and clearly.at the finish In addition, ensure that their number is placed visibly and not pointing to the right.

In the interests of your own safety the CTT advise you to wear a hard-shell helmet and to use a flashing rear light
