PROMOTED FOR AND ON BEHALF OF CYCLING TIME TRIALS UNDER THEIR RULES AND REGULATIONS.

Headquarters: Goostrey Village Hall, The Old Paddock, Goostrey CW4 8PE

Course – J2/9

START on Bomish Lane near to the entrance of Jodrell Bank Discovery Centre, at telegraph pole No 2 approx 300 yds west of the A535. East to and forward on the A535 to CHELFORD ISLAND (2.169 miles). Take second exit left on to the A537 & follow to the junction with Seven Sisters Lane at OLLERTON (5.219 miles). Left along the lane to the A50. Left on to the A50 & follow to the junction with Twemlow Lane at CRANAGE (11.408 miles). Left along the lane to join the A535 at Twemlow Green, left along the A535 to CHELFORD ISLAND (18.064 miles). Second exit left on the A537 to Seven Sisters Lane, left along the lane to join the A50, left along the A50 to FINISH (25.000 miles), opposite the northern gate post of a field gate almost opposite the entrance to Mount Pleasant Nursing Home, approx 500 yds past crossroads after Drover's Arms Public House. **Do not stop at or near the Finish!**

Race Numbers

These will be available at the HQ from 12.30 pm. Please return them after the event and sign out or you will be disqualified.

To get to the start

From HQ, turn R into Main Rd. After 100m turn L into Church Bank, which becomes Blackden Lane. At the Junction in 800m, take the right fork into Bomish Lane. Follow Bomish Lane passing the entrance to Jodrell Bank Discovery Centre to the start, approx. 1.9 miles from HQ. Allow at least 10 minutes.

Back to HQ from Finish

Continue along the A50 to the junction with New Platt Lane. Turn L into New Platt Lane & follow to its junction with Main Rd. Turn L on to Main Rd & follow back to HQ. Approx. 3.5 miles from the finish.

In the interests of your own safety

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with Reg.15 all junior competitors MUST wear protective hard shell helmets.

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.

No parking at the start or finish. Vehicles must not be parked, however briefly, in any part of the access area to Mound Pleasant Nursing Home, opposite the finish.

Riders must not stop at the finish but should continue on to the event headquarters where times will be displayed.



Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. Riders MUST NOT approach and encircle the island using tri-bars. Remember - traffic on the island has priority over traffic (including riders) entering it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.

Riders not to swing right before turning left into Twemlow Lane
 Riders not to swing right before turning left into Seven Sister Lane
