

No cars other than the Event Officials, to be parked at the Start/Finish area.

No U turns in sight of the start or finish.

No warming up by riders on the course after the event has started.

No Turbo Trainers are to be used for warming up within 100 metres of inhabited properties.

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the Event promoters, strongly advise all riders to wear a **HARD SHELL HELMET** that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. It is also recommended that a working rear light either flashing or constant is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

All competitors under the age of 18 years **MUST** wear a properly affixed helmet.

A litter bag will be provided approximately 10 meters before the time keepers at the start. Please place all litter, 'gel' wrappers etc., in this bag.
