Welcome to the 3RT Scammonden Dam Hill Climb, thank you for your entry and we look forward to seeing you on the day for a great day of competition.

This is 3RT's first HillClimb and we are thrilled to be using the Scammonden Dam private road, and we hope you will join us in thanking Yorkshire Water for allowing us to use this fantastic venue.

The Hill is very demanding and steep, climbing 204 ft at an average of 12% with 29% in the corners, but this is countered by the fact that it is relatively short at only 566m.

3RT also host a Criterium at York Raceway and the Dave Rayner Memorial Road Race at Norland each year and are pleased to add this HillClimb to their event list.

All events organised by 3RT are also used to raise funds for The Dave Rayner Fund, who support young cyclists in making the step up to a professional career. <u>www.thedaveraynerfund.co.uk</u>

DIRECTIONS:

The approximate nearest postcode for GoogleMaps for the event is **HD3 3FR** (but this will take you to a farm if you follow it all the way).

M62 Westbound – use J24

- Take first exit A643 Lindley Moor Road
- continue to next Roundabout
- take 3rd exit A640 New Hey Road
- follow road for about 2 ½ miles
- turn right onto Hey Lane

M62 Eastbound – use J23

- take 4th exit A640 New Hey Road
- follow road for about 2 ½ miles
- turn right onto Hey Lane

Event will be signposted from New Hey Road.

PARKING:

Competitor Parking:

Parking will be clearly signposted and is available on **ONE SIDE ONLY** on the grass verges approaching the venue. Take care when parking and park nose in where possible or instructed.

As this is a 'dead end' road, please follow the Marshals instructions to park. The sooner you arrive the nearer you will be to the venue. Please Car / Van share if at all possible, it will really help us. Thank you.

Spectator Parking:

It is important that any Spectators follow the Spectators Parking signs as this will help the Riders as room is limited. Spectators can then walk down the path to the Reservoir and then under the Underpass to the top of the course.

SIGNING ON:

Signing On is on the venue at the top of the climb.

JUNIORS: All riders 18 years and under must submit a signed parental consent form. PLEASE BRING THIS WITH YOU Parental Consent Form (Open Events) <u>http://www.cyclingtimetrials.org.uk/documents/index/guardians</u>

NUMBERS:

Race Numbers and Pins will be issued on signing on and can be kept as a souvenir. Please do not 'fold' numbers.

SIGNING OFF:

Please note under CTT rules, Riders **MUST** Sign Out otherwise they can be disqualified.

STRAVA SEGMENT:

Strava segment for the Course can be found here: <u>https://www.strava.com/segments/17824234</u> The Start is marked at the bottom of the Dam road & the finish is the last rainwater drain on Right before junction.

HELMETS:

In the interest of your own safety, the CTT and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard shell Helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety Standard.

CTT Regulation 15 requires all riders of 18 years and under to wear a suitable Helmet. Any Rider breaking this rule will not be allowed to start and record a DNS.

PRE EVENT PRACTICING:

The venue is open to the Public as it is also a footpath, however the top gate will be locked although there is a stile. If you wish to Recce/Practise the Course this is at your own risk & please ensure that you take litter away with you.

WARMING UP / PRACTICING ON THE DAY:

There is strictly No Warming Up or Practicing on the Course 10 minutes before the first Rider starts. **No U TURNS whatsoever.**

ROLLERS:

There will be 2 sets of Rollers to use at the bottom of the course for anyone who requires additional Warm Up just before the start. First come first served.

DESCENDING THE COURSE:

This is a dead end road with no other access to the bottom, so Riders are required to ride / walk down the Course to reach the Start Line. All Riders descending the Course MUST do so slowly and must be considerate of any competing Riders and / or Spectators - especially at the corners. Please be extra careful.

Please obey marshal's directions and instructions as they are there for your safety and to warn of approaching Riders. If directed to stop or dismount this MUST be adhered to.

REFRESHMENTS:

3RT are pleased to be working in partnership with both **Road Bloc Coffee** and **PastaMasta** to help support the event and they will be attending our Hill Climb to serve you. Don't hesitate to grab one of the finest Coffees or Pasta dishes around.

TOILETS:

Mobile toilets have been supplied. Please note these are unisex. Please note: there are No Access Toilets.

MEDICAL:

Medical Services by Julian Hall Medical Services. These services will be placed at the top of the Climb.

RESULTS:

There will be a RESULTS BOARD at the finish area which will be updated at regular intervals. Please do not approach the Time Keeper after your run as they need to concentrate on timing others.

Presentation of prizes will be at the Event after all the Climbs have finished and results compiled.
