43rd ANNUAL "GRANVILLE SYDNEY MEMORIAL" HILL CLIMB Saturday 8th October 2016 at 11.00 AM

The event is being held "For and run on behalf of cycling time trials under their rules & regulations". Course: V9912 Jackson Bridge (Staleyroyd Lane) HD9 7HX to Tinker's monument, Scar Hole Lane (New Field End) Cumberworth HD8 8YE

Distance:- 1540 yard long. Elevation gained 477ft. Average gradient of approx. 10%. Gradient varies from 20% to a slight dip shortly before a final ramp up to the finish. Fixed gears of around 60 inches are recommended.

Start:- 18 yards North of telegraph Pole/Lamp Standard D9071 and is exactly at the bottom most curb stone on the driveway to Staleroyd Farm on Staley Royd Lane, Jackson Bridge, Holmfirth

The climb:- Continue up Staleyroyd Lane and through Tenter Hill and onto Scar Hole Lane. Proceed up the hill to the finish.

Finish:- Is 3yards (SE) past the end of the dry stone wall abutting the garden wall of the house at the top of the hill on the left, (New Field End) which is at the junction with Intake Lane.

HQ Facilities: Race headquarters are at the **Jackson Bridge WMC**, Chapel Bank, Jackson Bridge HD9 1HR. There is car parking at the club and toilet facilities. Follow the A616 out of New Mill and past Red Lion pub which is on your right in less than 1 mile. Turn right after the pub and then first left on Chapel Bank and the club driveway is on the left on the bend. The race HQ is within ¼ mile of the start. There will be and tea,coffee & cake on sale for a small donation to Kirkwood Hospice.

Numbers: Please collect your number and "sign on" at the Headquarters and **return** the number after the event.

Safety: There are a number of blind corners on the course – please take extra care at these points. I N THE INTEREST OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets internationally accepted safety standards.

Record: The record for the hill is held by Jeff Wright who recorded 3 mins 49.9 secs to win at the National Championship in 1994.

Results: Results will be displayed at Headquarters. Presentation of the prizes will take place a soon as possible after the race to enable competitors to go the Holme Moss race.
