HQ details

HARVINGTON VILLAGE HALL, Station Road, Harvington, WR11 8NQ

From the start point, 2m towards Evesham on B4088, turn left into centre of Harvington village.

Parking: HQ only has a few parking spaces for officials. Parking is available along Village Street between B4088 & the HQ.

Signing on/out, race numbers, results & refreshments all at HQ

NOTE: new CTT Regulation for 2017; all competitors are now required to personally sign the Signing-Out sheet when returning their number. *Failure to do so will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF*

No cleats are to be worn in the Village Hall in case of damage to the floor

The start is approx 2 miles from the HQ/car parking, along the B4088 towards Dunnington

Please do not stop at the finish line; it is approx 3½ miles back to the HQ via Arrow & the start point

1 SP 064 532	Start on B4088 (Redditch - Evesham road) south of Dunnington crossroads at gully grating to south side of lane on left and opposite signpost to Dunnington village. Ride southwards (B4088)	0
2 SP 044 481	At Norton island junction take first exit	3.6
3 SP 082 513	At Salford Priors island junction with A46 take first exit (A46)	6.9
4 SP 086 563	At south Alcester island (Little Chef) take first exit (A435)	
5 SP 085	Finish before river Arrow at first gully grating to surfaced driveway on left by 5-barred gate with notice "ATCL fishing - private"	10

Safety

CTT & the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard-shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard, & that a working rear light be fitted to all machines

No Warming Up on the course after 2pm

Riders must exercise care at all times, obey CTT Regulation 20 & the Rules of the road & be considerate to other road users

Keep tight to the near-side on all left turns at the islands; do not approach the islands using aero-bars; remember that traffic on an island has priority. Keep it safe, & avoid possible disqualification & disciplinary action by being reported by Event Observers
