The same conditions apply to the YCF Team 25 on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> October (V232). Riders should enter this event as individuals, but there are no solo awards, all awards are for teams of 3 riders (handicap & actual). If entering on-line, and your 1<sup>st</sup> claim club is not affiliated to the YCF, but you have a 2<sup>nd</sup> claim club that is, please put a note in the "comments" section of your entry.

As this event was an Association Event, times recorded do not count for CTT national competitions (BARs etc), but will count for YCF competitions, and Yorkshire Best All-rounder competitions.
