1 Numbers and signing-on

Both body and arm numbers will be used. In accordance with Championship Conditions, only numbers provided by the organiser should be used. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16, and arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arm with number facing forward.

Please fix the numbers with pins only and remove the pins when returning the number to the official at the signing-out table. You must sign out when you return your number. You will be given a tea voucher when you return your number and sign-out.

Reserves ride with the number on the start sheet not the number of the ride they are replacing.

Will riders unable to make the race please inform the organiser by email, miriamhazelbaram@msn.com, as soon as possible so that reserves may be notified.

2. Juvenile riders and under-18 must supply a signed Parental Consent form when signing-on.

3. CTT Regulation 3, : Hill Climbs. Competitors
a) may be held up, but will not receive a push start.
b) may not cover any part of the course on foot.
c) must not be accompanied by persons on foot.

4. CTT Regulation 14. Competitor's machine. Fixed wheel machines must have a left hand threaded locking device securing the fixed sprocket. Machines with a fixed wheel only require a brake operating on the front wheel.

5). Competitors under the age of 18 and or juniors must wear a suitable helmet. In the interest of your own safety, Cycling Timetrials, and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets internationally accepted standards.
