A VERY WARM WELCOME

For the second time in a week we welcome riders and their families to the South Wales district and a time trial event on the A465. On Tuesday we hosted a 10-mile event in the Resolven area and today's 25-mile course shares nine of those ten miles. This means that it shares the turn-around point at the Aberdulais interchange, which has the potential to catch out first-time visitors to the area. Veterans of the course will be familiar with its "figure of eight" layout but rookies are encouraged to view this short video beforehand. We'll have marshals there to guide you but please do your homework in advance. The main thing to remember is that the R25/3H course is primarily run on a dual carriageway so you should look out for the GREEN road signs when turning back.

The R25/3H is a fast course and attracts riders from far and wide. This is great for everyone involved in the TT events but please spare a thought for the residents of Hirwaun. We'd like to maintain good relations so if you can't find a spot to park at the event HQ, please consider the various lay-by areas between the HQ and the start line. Additionally there's plenty of space around the Hirwaun Industrial Estate, which is also handy as a warm up area.

Our timekeepers are Norman James [Ogmore Valley Wheelers] and Tudor Thomas [Bynea Cycling Club], two great supporters of time trialling in the South Wales district and we thank them for their services once again.

Following your ride you can look forward to a free drink back at the HQ, plus a variety of snacks for the price of a donation. We'll get on with the prizegiving as soon as we possibly can, so please stick around for a chat if your schedule permits.

Here's hoping for some decent racing weather – see you on Sunday!

THE R25/3H COURSE

We'll have marshals stationed at the junctions but please remember that they're there for guidance only and have no authority to control traffic – again, here's a <u>one-minute video</u> of the turning point.

- > Start on access road to Hirwaun industrial estate (e293120/n206180, OS sheets 170/160) 8 yards north of lamp column number 1 and 30 yards north of junction with unclassified road (old a465) Hirwaun to Cefn Rhigos. 0.000 miles.
- Proceed south to junction with unclassified road (on to the old route) and bear left to roundabout with A4061 (Rhigos mountain road) where take second exit (straight on) to Hirwaun roundabout A465 to take first exit. 1.306 miles.
- Continue along A465 to Blaengwrach roundabout (McDonald's) to take second exit (straight on). 7.169 miles.
- Continue on A465 to Resolven roundabout to take third exit (straight on) 10.183 miles.
- ➤ Continue on A465 to exit at next junction (signpost Seven Sisters), climbing to the Tonna roundabout, where take first exit to Aberdulais interchange where circle roundabout and take fourth exit down slip road to re-join the A465 eastward. 15.063 miles.
- ➤ Continue along A465 to Resolven roundabout to take second exit (straight on) 19.719 miles.
- Continue on A465 to Blaengwrach roundabout (McDonalds). 22.764 miles.

➤ Take second exit continuing on A465, passing over river bridge and the Glynneath interchange to remain on A465 to finish in the second layby on the left at a point 25 yards west of the 'take litter home' sign and opposite the emergency telephone point. 25.014 miles.

DISTRICT RULES

All riders are asked to comply with the following.

- > Please call your number to the finishing timekeeper otherwise your time may not be recorded.
- Please keep your head up, be aware of your surroundings and HAVE A SAFE RIDE.
- In the interests of your own safety Cycling Time Trials and the Event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted standard. In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear protective helmets. It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
- This event may be subject to doping control. It's YOUR responsibility to check.
- > Sign in AND sign out; technically you haven't finished the event until you've signed out.
- Please don't pass the start time keeper or warm up on the course.
- > Don't use a turbo trainer within 100m of residential areas.
- ➤ Very importantly, the car park at the event HQ is also an entry into an out-of-hours surgery please don't block the latter, even for a short time.
- > Failure to follow these rules will result in a disqualification and referral to the South Wales DC for further disciplinary action.
